Friday 3 rd	Graduation Mass for Form Form5 and Upper 6	Held at St. Anthony's R.C. Church from 9:00 a.m. There will be regular school for Forms 1-4.
Monday 6 th	Dress Uniform	White shirt and black pants must be worn. Written excuses must be provided if the student does not wear his dress uniform. Failure to do so is an infringement of the school rules.
Thursday 9 th	Staff Meeting	School will be dismissed at 11:00 a.m. This is to facilitate a TTUTA meeting followed by a Staff meeting with teachers.
Monday 13 th - Friday 17 th	Coursework 1	During this week, Forms 1&2 will have the first of two Coursework exams.
Wednesday 15 th	Form 3 Career Day	This mandatory meeting must be attended by parents and students of Form 3. Subject choices for Form 4 classes as well as potential career options will be discussed. Parents must make every effort to attend this session which starts at 9:00 a.m. Students must be dressed in their proper school uniform.
Monday 20 th May - Friday 7 th June 2019	Hamper Donations	During this term, we ask parents/guardians to donate items to make hampers, which we distribute for our Feast Day. Your contributions towards these hampers go to homes of the less fortunate in our community. Every little item helps. Please donate during the period highlighted. Examples of bottle or food items include: oil, fruit juices, flour, rice, macaroni, sugar, tea, powdered milk, biscuits, tin products (peas, sausages, tuna, sardine etc). Detergent products can also be donated. Students/parents/guardians are asked to drop off these items in a box located in the office.

Thursday 30 th	Indian Arrival Day	Public holiday. There will be NO school on this day. Indian Arrival Day commemorates the arrival of the first Indian Indentured labourers from India to Trinidad on the ship <i>The FatelRazack</i> .

Monday 3 rd – Tuesday 11 th	Coursework 2	Forms 1&2 will have the second of their 2 Coursework tests. *Form 3's and 4's will not have a second Coursework examination this term.
Thursday 6 th – Tuesday 18 th	NCSE examinations	Form 3 students will sit the mandatory NCSE examinations. They will receive the timetable closer to this date. Missed examinations cannot be re-administered. All students are expected to do the NCSE examinations.
Thursday 13 th	Feast Day	Mandatory Final Mathematics exam in the morning for Forms 1,2 and 4, followed by Feast day celebrations. Exams start promptly at 8:15 a.m. *Form 3's have their NCSE English exam.
Friday 14 th	Proposed Principal's Holiday	Subject to Ministry of Education's approval.
Wednesday 19 th	Labour Day	Public holiday. There will be NO school on this day. Labour Day is the anniversary of the day of the Butler Oilfield Riots, which took place in 1937. Today, a statue of Butler stands at the Fyzabad Junction, also known as the Charlie King Junction, the place where the police attempted to arrest Butler on June 19 th .
Thursday 20 th	Corpus Christi	Public holiday. There will be NO school on this day. Corpus Christi is a Christian observance that honours the Holy Eucharist. It is known as the Feast of the Most Holy Body of Christ as well as the Day of Wreaths. One particular tradition is that many gardeners in Trinidad and Tobago will plant on Corpus Christi, believing it will ensure a thriving crop. Traditionally, some even bring their seeds to mass to be blessed by a priest so they'll be sure to thrive. Please remember to plant something.
