Calendar of Events: Term I (2019-2020)

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

Welcome back to St. Anthony's College and I hope that you all have settled well for the term thus far. I would like to take this opportunity to remind you about upcoming events scheduled for this term which is fifteen (15) weeks long. There will be End-of-Term examinations for ALL students. End of term reports will be collected during the Christmas vacation.

I would also like to reassure you that some of the classes last term had an assigned Maths teacher who was absent frequently. As a result, our other Maths teachers have been assisting these classes to ensure that the Curriculum is delivered to these students.

I also need to remind you to communicate with your Form Teachers and Deans throughout the term. Communication is imperative in order to guarantee that a child's cognitive, social and emotional development is progressing naturally. We must all take active roles to ensure that this occurs.

It is mandatory to send a note to the Form Teacher when a student is absent from classes. Additionally, excuses must be provided when any student does not wear his/her proper school uniform or dress uniform.

In an effort to build a Scrabble Club and Chess Club we are kindly asking for Scrabble Board Games and Chess Games to be donated to the school. These will be kept in the library under the supervision of our school's librarian.

You are to refresh yourself of the school rules as this encompasses everything from appearance to punctuality. Infringement of the school rules will result in the necessary disciplinary actions.

Reminders

- 1. Appearance:** Students must dress to look like students. They are not allowed to wear tight khaki pants with front seams; shirt collars are not to be creased; only black belts are to be worn; shoes must be all black; no jewellery of any form other than an appropriate watch is to be worn; and hair styles must adhere to the school rules.
- 2. Behaviour:** Students are expected to display appropriate behaviour on the way to school, at school and from school. Students must respect teachers and family at all times.
- 3. Punctuality:** Punctuality is important and students are required to be in school on time. School commences at 8:00 am and dismissal is at 2:20 pm. Parents/guardians are reminded that students must be picked up at a reasonable time, following the school's dismissal.
- 4. School signage:** Students MUST observe the signage throughout the school, especially the areas where they are not allowed, and in particular, the swimming pool facility where students must have permission and be supervised by teachers or coaches appointed to do so. It is a violation of the school rules for students go to the swimming pool facility without consent and supervision.

5. **Cell phones:** All cell phones must be switched off from the time the student enters the school compound until the end of the school day. Any phones seen or heard during the school day will be confiscated and returned to a parent ONLY. ABSOLUTELY NO PHONES WITH camera, video or audio recording devices are allowed. Only simple phones capable of sending and receiving phone calls and texts. In case of illness/emergencies, students must inform the school administration first, then the student will be allowed to use the school phone to contact parents/ legal guardians.
6. **Valuable possessions:** Students are reminded that they are not allowed to bring valuable possessions such as: iPods, Bluetooth devices, game boys. Additionally, laptops must be brought in ONLY upon the request of a teacher. (The school takes no responsibility for the loss of these items).
7. We thank you and encourage your continued contributions and donations (eg. reams of paper) towards the daily running of the school.
8. Parents/Guardians are reminded to contribute the \$300.00 per term. Monies can be brought to the office. Receipts will be provided upon payment.
